#### MISSION

To provide financial support to existing organizations in Latin America focused on improving the physical, intellectual, emotional, and spiritual well-being of children living in poverty.

#### PLAN

The objective of the Gloria M. & Mark H. Pollack Foundation is to identify Catholic organizations that are currently providing effective and meaningful care to children living in poverty in Latin America and fund those organizations on an ongoing basis in order to enhance and expand their capacity and reach.

Providing financial support to groups already engaged in supporting vulnerable populations allows the Foundation to reach as many children as possible in an efficient manner. The Foundation will not purchase real estate or undertake construction projects. It will also not be involved in daily operations of funded organizations.

Foundation staff based in the United States will: vet and present organizations to its Board of Directors for consideration; develop and maintain relationships with funded organizations and local foundation representatives; ensure the organizations meet standards and requirements for funding; and conduct site visits and audits.

Our hope is for impacted children to be educated to the greatest degree possible. If a child is capable of college education or special technical training, the Foundation will provide scholarship money to make this possible.

We will provide consultation services to funded organizations as needed.

### PERSONAL STATEMENT

For nearly two decades, I have been personally involved in and responsible for the existence of orphanages and food distribution centers for children in five countries in Latin America.

I never requested financial contributions for any of these activities. I did accept on-site involvement from qualified people to assist in the care of these children and to increase the ability of these institutions to provide services.

I have financed these operations completely out of my own personal funds and therefore could not expand as much as I would have wanted to. This new phase of my activities will have much greater funding. However, because of limitations due to age, my physical involvement will need to be more limited.

We anticipate that the investment proceeds of our donations will produce sufficient income to perpetuate the system and will not be requesting financial contributions from anyone, most especially local government.




The goal is to take children out of the cycle of material and spiritual poverty and give them the opportunity to become productive members of society according to their avocations.
